Number of projects using funds for staff: **177** (97% of all projects reporting)

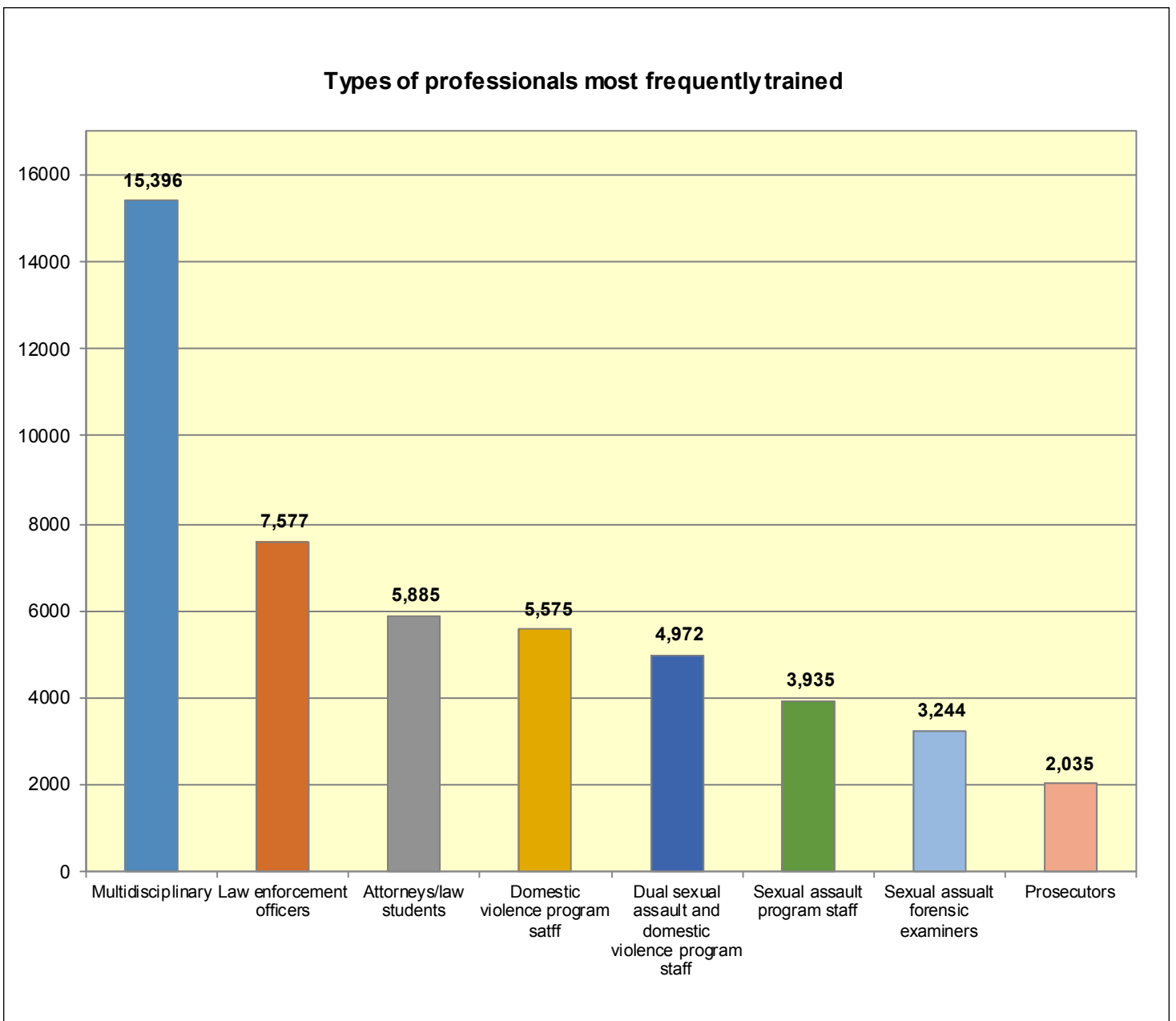

Number of training events: **975**

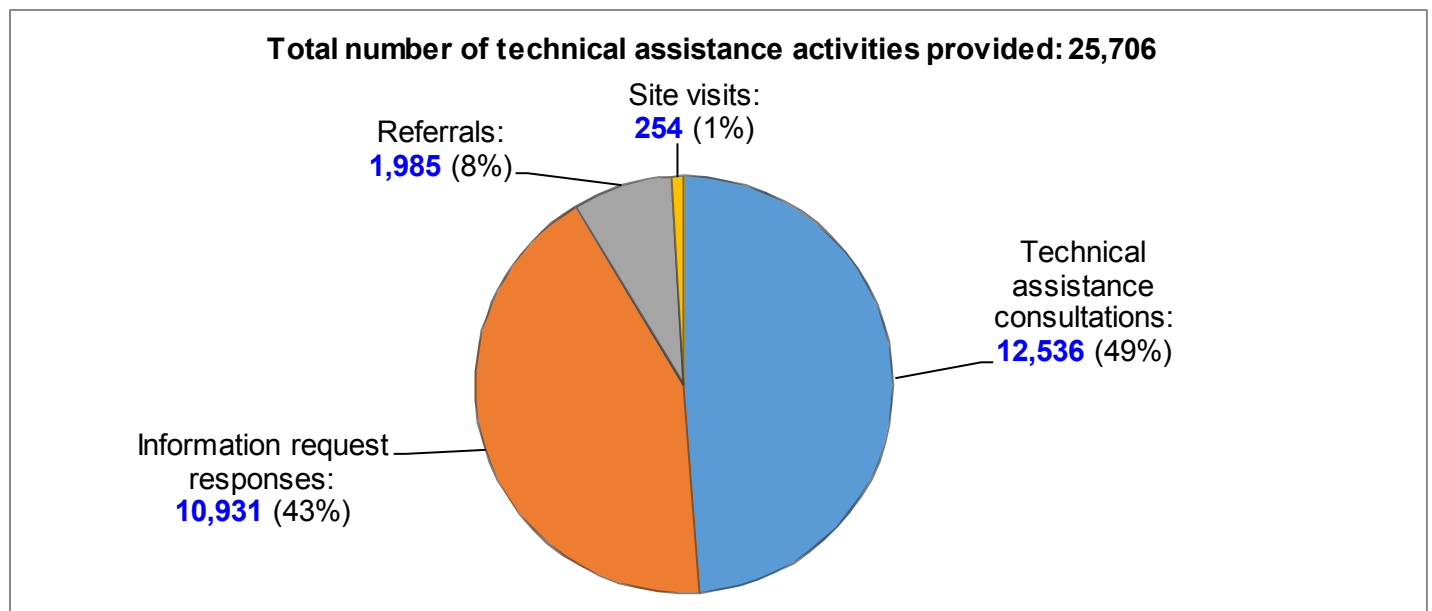
